## NOTICE OF PROTEST HEARING

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on May 31, 2016, at the hour of 9:00 a.m., in Conference Room 3001, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Tenth Street Place, 1010 Tenth Street, Modesto, California, the Stanislaus Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) will conduct a Protest Hearing regarding:

### **DISSOLUTION OF COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 2 (AIRPORT DISTRICT) AND COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 3 (RIVERDALE PARK TRACT)**

**Description:** This proposal was initiated by LAFCO to dissolve County Service Area (CSA) No. 2 (Airport District) and County Service Area (CSA) No. 3 (Riverdale Park Tract). The two CSAs are currently inactive, are not receiving revenue and are not providing services. The dissolutions will not impact services or create any new taxes or fees for residents within the CSA boundaries. CSA No. 2 (Airport District) is located south of Yosemite Boulevard, west of Tioga Drive, north of Hillside Drive and east of South Santa Rosa Avenue. CSA No. 3 (Riverdale Park Tract) is located at the South Carpenter Road and West Hatch Road intersection, south of the Tuolumne River, and north of West Hatch Road with parcels mostly west of the intersection.

**Purpose of Protest Hearing:** On April 27, 2016, the Stanislaus Local Agency Formation Commission heard and approved this dissolution proposal. The terms and conditions for the dissolution are set forth in LAFCO Resolution Nos. 2016-06 and 2016-07, which are available for review online and at the LAFCO office. At the Protest Hearing, the Executive Officer will hear and receive any oral or written protests, objections, or evidence which is made, presented, or filed regarding the proposed dissolutions.

**Your right to protest:** Any owner of land and/or registered voter within the affected territory who disapproves of the annexation may file a written protest against the proposal with the Executive Officer at any time on or after the publication date of this notice, and prior to the conclusion of the protest hearing. Please include your name, address, address of land owned within the affected area if different from your residence, Assessor's Parcel Number and the name of the proposal. Include your signature, and the date the signature was signed to the protest. All signatures without a date or bearing date prior to the date of publication of this notice, or submitted after the conclusion of the hearing, will be disregarded for purposes of ascertaining the value of written protests.

At the conclusion of the Protest Hearing, each protest will be counted separately. The results of protests received will be determined within 30 days following the hearing in accordance with California Government Code §57075 and 57078.
