**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT** the Stanislaus Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) will hold a public hearing on **Wednesday, March 24, 2021**, at a meeting starting at 6:00 P.M. in the Joint Chambers, Basement Level, Tenth Street Place, 1010 10<sup>th</sup> Street, Modesto, California, to consider the following:

**LAFCO APPLICATION NO. 2020-01, MUNICIPAL SERVICE REVIEW NO. 2020-03 & SPHERE OF INFLUENCE UPDATE NO. 2020-03 – SALIDA STORM DRAIN REORGANIZATION TO COUNTY SERVICE AREA 4:** Request to annex the Salida community (approximately 1,532 acres) into County Service Area (CSA) 4 to provide storm drain services to the entire Salida area. The proposal includes a divestiture of storm drain services from the existing CSA 10 and detachment of the Landmark Business Park area from CSA 10. (See attached map.) An updated Municipal Service Review and Sphere of Influence will also be considered for the proposal.

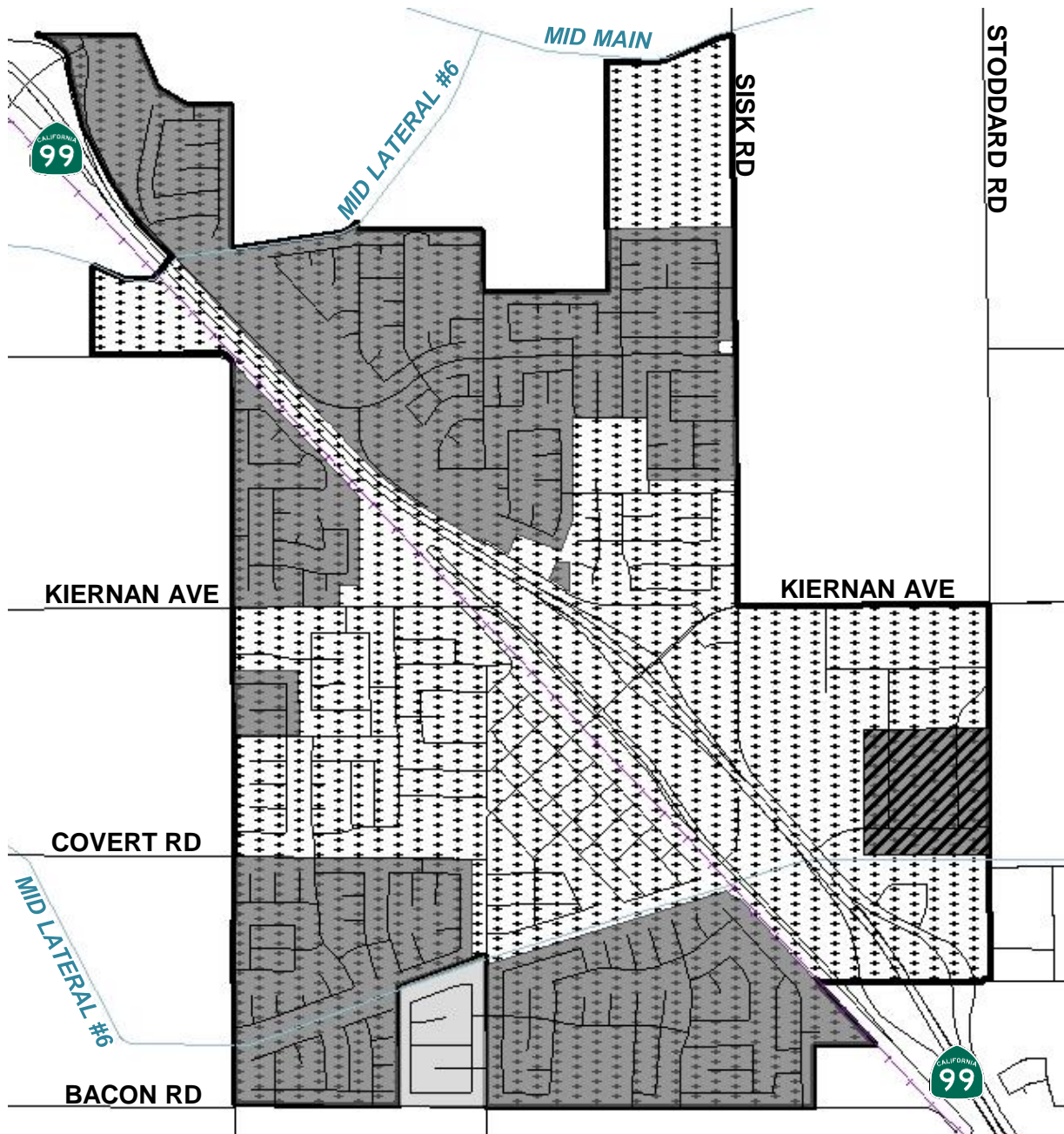
**This notice is intended to inform you of the proposal and the ability to provide your comments at or prior to Stanislaus LAFCO's public hearing.** Please be further advised that there is potential for the extension or continuation of a previously authorized charge, fee, assessment, or tax by Stanislaus County in the annexation area.

The proposal is considered exempt for purposes of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to §15061(b)(3) which exempts the project though the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. It has been determined with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment; the activity is not subject to CEQA.

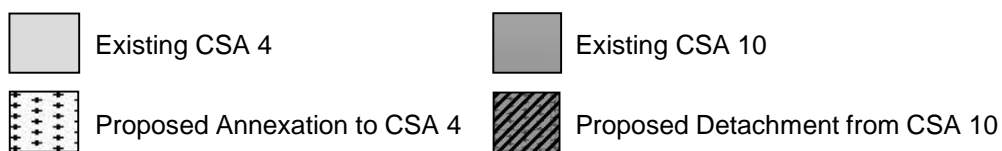
