Description: Request to annex approximately 53.47 acres to the City of Newman and

simultaneously detach the area from the West Stanislaus Fire Protection District and Central California Irrigation District. The City of Newman previously applied for a larger annexation area in 2018 which was terminated by election. The current proposal represents a smaller portion of Phase One of the Northwest Newman Master Plan. The project area is located northwest of the Newman City

Limits, west of Highway 33 and south of Stuhr Road. (See attached map.)
